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1. EDUCATION

Impact of Covid-19 on exams and results

- Final Exams for Grade 1- Grade 9 for Academic Term 2019-20 were held on March 2020. The results for the exams were postponed until November 2021.
- Grade 10 Exams were not held and all the students were automatically passed as per order of government.
- Exams were not conducted for College (Grade 11 & 12) and University in 2020. All exams for college and university were postponed to 2021.

Impact of Covid-19:

- Starting 19-March-2020, the schools were closed and first lockdown started in Nepal on 24-March-2020. The schools reopened with some restrictions after lockdown from October 2020.
- The results for final exams (Academic term 2019-2020) held on March 2020 were postponed and we receive the results only around November 2020. Final exam for Grade 10 was not held and everyone was passed. The results for Class 8 (District level exam) was delayed.
- Exams for College (Grade 11 & 12) and University were not held in 2020 and postponed to 2021.
- Students dropped out due to migration. Once the lockdown started, many families returned back to their native villages.
- The enrollment for academic year 2020-21 did not start until October 2020. The system was bit confusing. The enrollment for 2020-21 started even before results for final exams for Academic year 2019-20 was declared.
- Regular classes were impacted and students went to school for only around 3 months for the entire academic year 2020-21. The start of online classes were also delayed as many schools were not used to such classes.

The school enrollment for 2020-21 started October 2020, was postponed from April 2020 due to school closure during pandemic.

Each Daycare center has two staffs- Daycare Teacher and Daycare Assistant & Cook.

Impact of Covid-19 on Daycare (2020)

Due to the pandemic and closure of all educational institutions, the Daycare remained closed starting March 24th, 2020. The students from 2019 batch could not be enrolled into school until late September and they started attending school only from November.

During the lockdowns, the Daycare students came to the center once a week to collect their weekly homework.

From our field visits, we had already shortlisted new students for Daycare but they could not be enrolled in 2020. So, we had no new enrollments for 2020.

Daycare Student List (2019 & 2020)

A total of 30 students were enrolled in Mayaa Daycares in 2019 and they continued Daycare till October 2020 until schools opened up.

3. ASSISTANCE TO SCHOOLS

Mahankal Little Garden project

Mayaa Nepal supports and maintains vegetable farming project for Mahankal School. Farming equipment and workers are also provided by Mayaa. During 2020, leafy greens, corn and soybean were harvested from the Little Garden in Mahankal. Before lockdowns, the harvest was used for children's lunch. After lockdowns, the harvest was distributed to needy families in the area.

Challenges:

1. Water shortage in the area and we have to depend mostly on rain.
2. The soil is not very fertile.
3. Monkeys destroying and stealing the crops.
4. School not taking responsibility for the farm.

Canteen & Lunch for Mahankal School

The canteen for Mahankal School was built and all equipment, utensils, furniture etc. were provided by Mayaa Nepal.

Lunch for Mayaa students in Mahankal School is supported by Mayaa Nepal. The food from the Little Garden in Mahankal is used for student's lunch. Once a week, bananas and eggs are provided to all the students.

School Library, Purano Gusheshwori

The library for Purano Guheshwori School was built by Mayaa Nepal. The books were also provided by Mayaa.

We regularly monitor the library and maintain the books. We worked with the school to lay own rules on how to effectively run the library this year.

Volunteer teachers (extra classes) for Nepal Ratna, Ichangu, Puano Guheswori & Mahankal School

Mayaa volunteers take extra classes in the schools we support to help the students mainly with English, communication skills and IT/Computer skills. They also assist with other subjects as per the interest of the volunteers. The volunteers conduct extra-curricular activities, games and workshops and introduce students to new and exciting ideas that stimulates the students and broadens their perspectives.

Impact of Covid-19 on School Assistance:

All schools closed from 19th March and reopened with restrictions around late September. The majority of the year, we could not work with the schools.

4. FAMILY SUPPORT AND COUNSELING

Home visits are conducted for each Mayaa student at least once a month. For students and families facing any issues, we follow up on them multiple times until the issue is resolved.

Goal of home visits:

- To communicate effectively with the families and the students.
- To monitor the living conditions of the family.
- To observe any issues that may need our attention.
- To understand if the family is facing shortage in anyway-monetary, food, healthcare.
- To provide advice and counseling.

Counseling Project (January-April 2020)

We teamed up with Department of Psychology, Tri-Chandra Multiple Campus for counseling for our parents and children. 8 psychologists conducted sessions for Mayaa students and parents starting January to April 2020.

A total of 62 parents and children were provided with counseling.

Types of Counseling provided:

Early Childhood Counseling for Daycare students

One of the psychologists was an expert in early childhood development and she observed our Daycare children in the classroom and provided counseling for the selected students and their parents.

Individual counseling for students and families

Individual counseling were provided depending on each individual case on various topics like education, substance abuse, depression, abuse etc. The sessions was conducted at Mayaa center and also in the student's homes. Multiple sessions were conducted for those in need.

Group Counseling

Apart from individual counselling sessions, the psychologists also provided group sessions targeted specifically for groups of boys, girls and students with issues at home and in schools.

Family Support during lockdowns:

Home Visits & Follow-up on families

We kept in touch with all the families regularly during the lockdowns. We tried our best to meet them as often as possible. During the strict curfews, we communicated mostly through phone as travel was restricted.

We interviewed each of our student individually during the lockdowns to know how they are dealing with the pandemic and lockdown and if their family faced any issues.

Students and Parents Meeting

Group and Individual meetings were held with the parents and students as per need once to address various issues and to give parents a chance to put their concerns forward.

CDB (Child Development Bank)

The money from CDB (Child Development Bank), a savings scheme for parents by Mayaa, where the parents save some amount for money for safe keeping. The money from CDB was returned to the parents during the lockdowns.

Food Support for families

We made sure that all Mayaa supported families were enrolled in the free groceries program by Nepal government. Basic items like basic items like rice, oil, flour, sugar etc. were provided. The groceries were distributed once in two weeks and the amount of grocery was rationed according to the number of family members.

For families with financial difficulties, we distributed groceries at regular intervals. The families were provided with items like Rice, Dal (lentils), Dried Gram/Peas/Soybean (Legumes), Beaten rice, Wheat Flour, Cooking oil, Salt and Neutrala (Soya chunks).

Vegetables from Little Garden Project

Since daycare and schools remained closed, the vegetables from both the Little Garden-Mayaa Center and Mahankal were distributed to the families in need. Maya staffs themselves worked at the garden to maintain the farm along with the two mothers of Mayaa student. The two mothers receive income from Mayaa which is beneficial for them.

Vegetable from the field- Cauliflower, Potatoes, Radish, Carrot, Spinach and other greens, Tomatoes, Cucumber, Zucchini, Pumpkin stalks, Soybean, Pole beans, Yad Long Beans, Corn, Garlic, Chilies, Turmeric & Parsley were distributed to the families.

Room Rent Support

Room rent is supported for the neediest families.

Clothes Distribution

Clothes were distributed regularly both for students and their families.

5. HEALTH & AWARENESS

Health Camp: We conduct free Health Camps in all our working areas to support the health and well-being of the students and their parents. Since 2018 our health camps have been more focused on children's needs. The Health camps we conduct mostly are Pediatric, Eye, ENT and Dental. The health camps help us address the most common health issues in students. All medicines are provided free of costs during the Health camps. For other health needs, we have partnered with various hospitals and clinics.

Mayaa in-house Doctor: Dr. Binita Mandal, Pediatric Doctor (visits once every week and when needed).

Enrollment check-up- Full health check-up for newly enrolled students and collection of medical history.

Health check-up for Daycare students- Once a week, stool test at the time of enrollment and BMI record every month.

Health Support for students and families - Free Health check-up for students, parents and also children from local areas with free medicines and hospital referral by Mayaa in-house doctor.

Medicine Support- Mayaa maintains a stock of medicines that are provided free of cost.

Health treatment support – Monetary support for families unable to afford treatment.

Medical Record book – A health book for each Mayaa student to record their BMI, diagnosis and treatment from Health check-ups and camps and medical history.

Hospital Referral Support: For the parents and for further diagnosis and treatment, we have partnered up with various hospitals and clinics to provide treatment free of cost or at discounted cost. Below are the list of health institutions we work with:

- Nepal Malnutrition Rehabilitation Center (Extreme Malnutrition)- Free

Awareness program: To raise health awareness and reduce potential diseases.

Impact of Covid-19 on Health Camps, Health-check-up & Awareness program

Out target for 2020 was 12 Health Camps and 12 Awareness program, and check-up for students once a month by Mayaa in-house doctor. Due to the Covid lockdowns and restrictions, we were unable to meet our target for the year and were able to function normally only till March. Restrictions on mass gatherings also prevented us from conducting Health camps and Awareness programs even after lockdown relaxation.

However, we still provided free medicines and some health check-up for those in need throughout the year. We also conducted individual meetings with students and parents to raise health awareness.
