1. EDUCATION

Mayaa Nepal provides comprehensive education support to underprivileged children in slum areas of Kathmandu, ensuring they have the opportunity to access quality education and break the cycle of poverty. Without this support, many of these children would be unable to enroll in school and would miss the chance to build a brighter future.

Education Support Includes:

- School Admission and Monthly Fees
- School Uniforms (two sets)
- Copies, Stationery, and School Books
- Food Support

Key Activities to Foster Holistic Development:

- Regular follow-ups through monthly home visits and weekly school attendance tracking

- Collaboration with teachers to monitor student performance and behavior
- Individual meetings with students to address concerns and provide guidance
- Exam result follow-ups and additional tuition classes at the center
- Computer/IT classes and laptops for senior students
- Career counseling and course selection guidance for older students
- Engaging extra-curricular activities, including art, games, and movie sessions

This multifaceted approach not only ensures children stay in school but also provides them with the tools and guidance they need to thrive academically and personally.

2. DAYCARE

Mayaa Daycare is a vital initiative supporting children aged 2.5–4 years from underprivileged families, preparing them for school while providing a secure environment that allows parents to pursue employment. By addressing the educational, health, and nutritional needs of children, the daycare fosters holistic child development and promotes family economic stability.

Objectives:

Educational Support: Preparing children for formal education through engaging activities that enhance cognitive and social skills, ensuring a seamless transition into school.

Parental Employment Facilitation: Enabling parents to work and generate income by providing a safe space for their children, fostering economic stability and community growth.

Services Provided:

a. Education: Educational games and activities are incorporated to make learning enjoyable.

b. Recreation and Entertainment: Recognizing the importance of play in a child's development, the daycare provides recreational activities and entertainment to promote physical activity, creativity, and emotional well-being.

c. Health Check-ups: Regular health check-ups are conducted to monitor the children's well-being. This ensures early detection of potential health issues and allows for timely intervention, promoting overall health.

d. Hygiene Practices: Daycare places a strong emphasis on maintaining a clean and hygienic environment. Children are taught essential hygiene practices, fostering habits that contribute to their long-term well-being.

e. Nutritious Meals: The daycare provides balanced and nutritious meals, addressing the nutritional needs of the children. This not only supports their physical development but also contributes to their overall health.

3. FAMILY SUPPORT AND COUNSELING

Home visits are conducted for each Mayaa student at least once a month. For students and families facing any issues, we follow up on them multiple times until the issue is resolved.

Goal of home visits:

- To communicate effectively with the families and the students.
- To monitor the living conditions of the family.
- To observe any issues that may need our attention.
- To understand if the family is facing shortage in anyway-monetary, food, healthcare.
- To provide advice and counseling.

Food support was provided to struggling families. The provided food items were rice, lentils, pulses, salt, cooking oil, soybean, chickpea, beaten rice, flour, pasta, blanket, Eggs and vegetables from little garden.

Parents meeting was held to keep them informed of the rules and to understand their concerns.

4. HEALTH

Health Camp: We conduct free Health Camps in all our working areas to support the health and well-being of the students and their parents. Since 2018 our health camps have been more focused on children's needs. The health camps we conduct mostly are Pediatric, Eye, ENT, Gyno and Dental. The health camps help us address the most common health issues in students. All medicines are provided free of costs during the Health camps. For other health needs, we have partnered with various hospitals and clinics.

Mayaa in-house Doctor: Dr. Binita Mandal, Pediatric Doctor (visits once every week and when needed).

Enrollment check-up- Full health check-up for newly enrolled students and collection of medical history.

Health check-up for Daycare students- Once a week, stool test at the time of enrollment and BMI record couple of months.

Health Support for students and families - Free Health check-up for students, parents and also children from local areas with medicines and hospital referral by Mayaa in-house doctor.

Medicine Support- Mayaa maintains a stock of medicines that are provided free of cost.

Health treatment support – Monetary support for families unable to afford treatment.

Medical Record book – A health book for each Mayaa student to record their BMI, diagnosis and treatment from health check-ups and camps and medical history.

Hospital Referral Support: For the parents and for further diagnosis and treatment, we have partnered up with various hospitals and clinics to provide treatment free of cost or at discounted cost. Below are the list of health institutions we work with:
